**Note: Read the instructions carefully before attempting the answers:**

(i)	The Question Paper is divided into 2 Sections i.e. Section - A and Section - B.
(ii)	The Examinee is required to attempt any 3 (three) Questions from Section - A, and any 2 (two) Questions from Section - B. Figures in the margin indicate the Marks.
(iii)	The assignment has to be submitted in a <b>handwritten form</b> . No other format would be acceptable.
(iv)	The examinee has to write the answer in <b>A4 Size or equivalent size sheets</b> , ruled or un-ruled.
