# ABOUT RMLNLU

# ABOUT ADR BOARD

The vibrant ADR Board of RMLNLU, working under the aegis of Legal Aid Committee of the university, is a solely student body responsible for organizing inter and intra - varsity ADR competitions. RMLNLU National Mediation Competition 2019 is the fifth edition, since 2012, that will be successfully organised by the ADR Board, entailing participation from various law schools of India. The student fraternity of RMLNLU actively participates in CLINEME, the intra-university ADR tournament responsible for sending competitive teams from the university to various national mediation, negotiation and client counseling competitions in an academic year.



# V RMLNLU NATIONAL MEDIATION COMPETITION

The Legal Aid Committee aspires to further its commitment of promoting ADR mechanisms by raising the bar higher for the V edition of the RMLNLU National Mediation Competition 2019. The Competition garnered a quality participation of 32 teams from various law schools across the nation. We have continued our collaboration with PACT as the Chief Advisory Organisation for the current edition. In addition to this, this year, the orientation session will be taken by decorated experts in the field of ADR, separately for negotiators and mediators. The objective is to widen the scope of the competition, by not letting it confined to the title of Mediation, but also other segments of ADR as well.





## FORMAT OF THE COMPETITION

A team shall consist of two members- one playing the role of a mediator and the other of a negotiator. In its one-of-a-kind pattern, there shall be two mediators from different teams and two different negotiators (all four from different teams) competing against each other in a session.

Each team shall contest in two preliminary rounds. The top eight mediators and negotiators, based on their cumulative scores in both the prelim rounds, shall qualify for the quarter-finals. The top four mediators and negotiators will make it to the semi-finals and the top two for finals.



# PACT - CHIEF ADVISORY ORGANISATION

The Peacekeeping and Conflict Resolution Team (PACT) is a collective of law professionals who share the vision of promoting the use of consensual dispute resolution (CDR). Anchored in New Delhi, The PACT aims to catalyse the development of CDR in India and abroad, through its innovative initiatives, such as the ADR / CDR advocacy training for young lawyers (GAADR), the arbitration-mediation contest for law students (Advocate Maximus), the community dispute resolution competition (Intercessionis), skill-based awareness drives (boot camps), etc. Having reached out to over 5,300 law students and lawyers, travelled across 18 Indian states and collaborated with dozens of national and international experts and organisations, The PACT has grown into a creative and sustainable force for CDR enthusiasts looking to explore negotiation and mediation as their primary armour in addressing and resolving conflict.

**The semi-finalists shall also be enriched with resources in the field of ADR.**




# Participation
