







ABCUT

The Legal Aid Committee (LAC), operating within the university, functions as a student organization committed to offering legal aid and spearheading initiatives to raise social awareness. Its primary objective is to leverage the legal knowledge of students to provide free legal assistance to individuals facing significant challenges.

The Committee recruits students, encouraging them to utilize their understanding of the law to offer pro bono legal support through various channels. The Legal Aid Committee is involved in a diverse range of activities, including preventive, remedial, activist, and reformative efforts.

Additionally, the dynamic Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) wing of the university is run by LAC. This student-led body is solely responsible for organizing both inter and intra-university ADR competitions, playing a pivotal role in promoting alternative dispute-resolution mechanisms.







LEGAL AID CAMP

The Legal Aid Committee in collaboration with the District Legal Services Authority ('DLSA'), Lucknow and the Uttar Pradesh State Legal Services Authority ('UPSLSA') along with the unwavering support of Ministry of Law and Justice organizes legal aid camps in the villages around Lucknow. Since 2012, the Committee has organized them in remote areas, identifying the most pressing issues of the region and helping to actively resolve them. The main aim of these camps is to assuage the grievances in the legal field which are faced by the poor population of the respective village.

Prior to a camp, students visit the target villages for Pre-Camp surveys and understand the concerns of the public. A detailed form of questions pertaining to various issues, government schemes, basic amenities, functioning and cooperation of various departments, etc. is drafted and volunteers get it filled by people of over 150 houses during these visits. These visits have proved beneficial in raising awareness of people about the various schemes as well as the camp being organised.

The recent camp conducted in September 2023 drew over 2000 attendees, focusing on schemes such as Ujjawala Yojana, MGNREGA, Ayushmann Bharat, Fasal Bima, etc., and addressing issues related to ration, pension, and employment. The active participation of local government officials, including the BDO, ADM, DSO, and Member Secretary of the SLSA., significantly enhanced the efficiency and success of the camp. This initiative provides an opportunity to serve the general public while upholding the values of social justice that the committee stands for.

ASHA

Project ASHA, spearheaded by the Legal Aid Committee in collaboration with the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), is a crucial initiative aiming to ensure equal protection for prisoners in Lucknow. Recognizing that equal protection under the law is not only a state mandate but a collective responsibility, the project focuses on addressing the grievances of undertrial prisoners.

The primary objective is to alleviate the challenges faced by prisoners in the legal process. Through regular visits to prisons across Lucknow, committee members conduct comprehensive surveys. These surveys evaluate factors such as legal literacy, the status of appeals, and living conditions within the prison premises. The collaboration with DLSA strengthens the project's impact, combining resources and expertise to provide extensive legal aid and support.

It places a spotlight on three key focus areas: enhancing legal literacy among prisoners, expediting the resolution of pending appeals, and advocating for improved living conditions. By addressing these aspects, the committee strives to safeguard the fundamental rights of prisoners, ensuring they have access to justice and humane treatment.









SHIKSHA

Project Shiksha is dedicated to the empowerment of underserved communities through the provision of accessible and quality education. The project focuses on developing culturally relevant curricula, ensuring that educational content aligns with local contexts. Despite challenges such as limited infrastructure and resource constraints, Project Shiksha employs innovative solutions, including mobile learning units and strategic partnerships with local non-profit organizations. These measures aim to overcome obstacles and enhance the reach and impact of the initiative.

In a recent session held in the slum area of Aliganj, it extended its reach to raise awareness about various social issues and educate stakeholders about their rights and legal remedies. The team addressed crucial topics such as Eve teasing, Domestic Violence, One Stop Centres, and FIRs. Providing a brief description, significance, relevant helpline numbers, and services or protections offered, the session aimed to empower women by enhancing their awareness. Additionally, sanitary napkins were distributed to attendees, emphasizing the holistic approach of the project.

By providing access to education and empowering individuals, the <u>initiative exemplifies a</u> collective commitment to building a brighter and more equitable future for <u>underserved</u> communities.









BLOOD DONATION CAMP

The Legal Aid Committee, as part of its operational activities, collaborates with the NGO Blood Connect to organize impactful Blood Donation Camps. This significant event garners participation not only from the student fraternity but also from the faculty and office staff of the University.

The camp is conducted under the supervision of a registered medical practitioner, the donors are thoughtfully provided with necessary nourishment post the donation process. These Blood Donation Camps organized by the Legal Aid Committee serve as a substantial contribution to health authorities, aiding in the maintenance of blood banks. Beyond that, it plays a crucial role in assisting individuals in need of blood, alleviating their challenges in securing this vital resource.

This dedicated commitment to organizing Blood Donation Camps underscores the committee's unwavering dedication to both community welfare and healthcare support, reflecting its broader impact on fostering a culture of social responsibility and humanitarian assistance.













INTERNATIONAL MEDIATION COMPETIITON

The ADR wing of the Legal Aid Committee has been steadfast in its commitment to fostering an Alternative Dispute Resolution culture within the Indian legal system. Annually, the ADR wing organizes the International Mediation Competition (IMC), a prestigious event that draws participants and ADR enthusiasts from around the world. Recognized as one of the oldest and most esteemed ADR competitions in South Asia, the IMC, hosted by the ADR wing of the Legal Aid Committee at RMLNLU, serves as a platform for diverse student teams and ADR experts to refine their skills.

The 2TG-RMLNLU International Mediation Competition, 2024, marked the 10th edition of this flagship ADR tournament, symbolizing a decade of unwavering dedication and continual growth. Since its inception in 2012, the ADR wing of RMLNLU, Lucknow had been dedicated to advancing cost-effective alternative dispute resolution techniques and fostering conciliation and peacebuilding by offering national and international participants a platform to learn and demonstrate effective mediation. This competition had been a stimulating opportunity for participants to connect with renowned ADR experts from across the globe. The 10th edition of the 2TG-RMLNLU International Mediation Competition was a resounding success, with participation of 23 national & international universities.

CLINEME

The ADR Wing of the Legal Aid Committee organizes the annual intra-competition known as "CLINEME". Clineme serves as a pivotal event influencing the development and promotion of ADR culture within the university, providing participants with hands-on experience in client counselling, negotiation and mediation. It comprises two segments: Client Counselling and Negotiation Mediation

O1 CLIENT COUNSELLING

Client Counselling involves participants, acting as attorneys, facing the challenge of extracting information from a prospective client through precise and comprehensive lines of questioning. The emphasis lies on obtaining crucial information while ensuring the client feels at ease. Participants are evaluated based on their ability to elicit information at the core of the client's issue, their hospitality, and the appropriateness of suggested remedies.

O2 NEGOTIATION - MEDIATION

The Negotiation & Mediation segment features sessions where two mediators and four negotiators work together in a room to resolve a dispute through fictional role-play scenarios. The Negotiation & Mediation segment not only enhances participants' skills in resolving disputes through strategic negotiation but also cultivates their proficiency in facilitating mediation processes, giving them valuable hands-on experience in negotiation and meditation techniques for effective conflict resolution.


Students from IIM, RMLNLU turn saviours for patients fighting Covid
